HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS: A 43-year-old Caucasian male, being presented on voluntary admission to his SBU AP seen at SOMC ER for psychiatric evaluation secondary to obsessive thoughts. During the admission, the patient presented hyperv verbal with circumstantial thoughts. Identified reason for admission as being accused of child molestation by friend's ex-girlfriend. According to the patient, admitted to lying at the request of their mother. The patient reported that he became upset after three different police department refused to arrest friend's ex-girlfriend for false accusation. The patient stated he became so upset he went to the ER looking for Xanax, then he was admitted. Feeling hopeless, helpless, worthless.

HOSPITAL COURSE: During hospitalization, the patient improved. The mood is stabilized, complying with treatment, psychiatrically stable, being discharged.

REFERENCE TO PRIOR VERBAL COMMUNICATION WITH OUTSIDE PROVIDERS: Dr. Abenante, 03/22/2022 at 1300 hours, Pathways 03/17/2022 at 1145 hours.

MEDS INCLUDING DOSES: Latuda 60 mg daily with dinner, miconazole applied to affected area twice a day, metformin 1000 mg twice a day, loratadine 10 mg daily, Lantus insulin 15 units subcutaneous at bedtime, glipizide 10 mg before breakfast, gabapentin 300 mg 3 times a day, fluticasone nasal 50 mcg per inhalation spray, 1 spray daily p.r.n. congestion, atorvastatin 10 mg after dinner, albuterol 3 mL every 4 hours shortness of breath.

CONDITION ON DISCHARGE: Not suicidal, not homicidal, not psychotic. Able to be discharged.

FINAL DIAGNOSIS: Axis I: Bipolar disorder, manic, severe in remission.

For someone without known diabetes, a hemoglobin A1c value of 6.5% or greater indicates that they may have diabetes and this should be confirmed with a follow-up test.

For someone with known diabetes, a value <7% indicates that their diabetes is well controlled and a value greater than or equal to 7% indicates suboptimal control. A1c targets should be individualized based on duration of diabetes, age, comorbid conditions, and other considerations.

Currently, no consensus exists regarding use of hemoglobin A1c for diagnosis of diabetes for children.

Pt is a 43 y/o SWM who was initially seen at SOCH after presenting to the ED for anxiety and OCD, Pt signed self in voluntary but after being on the unit for 2 days and is asking to leave. Pt does not have any prior hospitalizations and is not known to PESS. Pt does have a psychiatrist and therapist that he has been seeing for the past several years.

Writer met with the Pt via telehealth at SBU. Pt presented cooperative with no distress and was observed to be making jokes and laughing. Pt reported that this was a misunderstanding and he would like to get discharged. Pt said, "My friend who I was in the military with is going through a divorce and his soon to be ex-wife accused me of molesting their daughters." Pt reported that the ex-wife wants full custody so she made up the story that Joe allowed Pt to molest the daughters. Pt stated that he had been increasingly anxious and stressing out. "I went to the ED hoping to get medications for my anxiety, I was already taking Lexapro and yesterday on the inpatient unit they switched me to Latuda." Pt stated that he had filed a report with the police department and DCPD was contacted, per Pt the police and DCPD are following up. Pt adamantly denied that he wants to hurt anyone and himself. Pt reported that he is going to let the professionals take care of it and he wants to continue with his life. Pt stated that he enjoys bowling, golfing and spending time with friends. Pt denied any issues with sleep and appetite and does not present as psychotic.
