1 MR. CAMPBELL: Nice to meet you.

2 OFFICER BLEICHNER: You too. Just to let you
3 know, this is going to be audio-video recorded --

4 MR. FABOZZI: Yes.

5 OFFICER BLEICHNER: -- okay?

6 MR. FABOZZI: Okay.

7 OFFICER BLEICHNER: If there is a call -- you
8 guys can do it right here.

9 MR. FABOZZI: Yes.

10 OFFICER BLEICHNER: If there -- you can sit
11 down, Joe, you don't have to stand, man. If there is a
12 call, I do have to leave. I'm just letting you both
13 know, okay? But I'm going to stand over here --

14 MR. FABOZZI: That's recording, right?

15 OFFICER BLEICHNER: Yup.

16 MR. FABOZZI: (Inaudible) both?

17 OFFICER BLEICHNER: And this -- this is audio
18 and video.

19 MR. FABOZZI: Does that (inaudible) audio?

20 OFFICER BLEICHNER: This does, Joe.

21 MR. FABOZZI: All right. All right.

22 OFFICER BLEICHNER: Everything you -- you in
23 here, okay?

24 MR. CAMPBELL: Okay. So we received this
25 referral on February 2nd. (Interference). Her school

1 reported concerns. I'm actually going to read directly
2 from the report. (Interference), so there's no other -
3 - no other details known. (Interference).

4 MR. FABOZZI: What is IEP?

5 MR. CAMPBELL: It's an Individual Education
6 Plan. It's for children who are in Special Education,
7 so it doesn't pertain to you. So of course I just have
8 to follow up on that. It's our protocol --

9 MR. FABOZZI: Hold on. What about the part
10 where he told Joey that [MINOR CHILD] said mommy told me to
11 say that in front of the cop.

12 MR. CAMPBELL: So I'm going to get to that.
13 May I ask you the questions first.

14 MR. FABOZZI: No. Why don't we get to that
15 first?

16 MR. CAMPBELL: So this is
17 (inaudible) --

18 MR. FABOZZI: Am I being unruly?

19 OFFICER BLEICHNER: Well, Joe, just let him
20 speak. I'm here just --

21 MR. FABOZZI: Okay. I'll stop. Go ahead,
22 speak, I'll stop.

23 OFFICER BLEICHNER: I'm here just so it's
24 recorded, Joe.

25 MR. FABOZZI: I'm stopping. Go.

1 MR. CAMPBELL: So whenever we get a call of
2 child abuse or neglect, we have to go out and interview
3 the children. When interviewing the child, the child
4 disclosed to me that she believes you touches (sic)
5 children, (interference), she never observed you touch
6 anyone.

7 Then when later on questioned, I ask her,
8 well, how does she know. She said, oh, her mommy
9 stated it. So, I still have to ask you because
10 (interference), so that's why I'm asking you, have you
11 ever had any type of contact (interference)?

12 MR. FABOZZI: No.

13 MR. CAMPBELL: Okay. Have you ever been left
14 unsupervised with [MINOR CHILD]

15 MR. FABOZZI: No.

16 MR. CAMPBELL: Okay. That's all.

17 MR. FABOZZI: I want a copy of where the mom
18 said --

19 MR. CAMPBELL: You're not -- you don't --
20 you're not allowed --

21 MR. FABOZZI: That's not fair --

22 MR. CAMPBELL: -- to have a copy.

23 MR. FABOZZI: -- she made a false allegation
24 against me.

25 MR. CAMPBELL: This is an investigation.

1 She did make a false allegation. This is what
2 happened. She overheard her mother have an adult
3 conversation where you stated -- you were at a Sweet 16
4 party, correct?

5 MR. FABOZZI: No, because I was not at the
6 Captain's Inn.

7 MR. CAMPBELL: Okay. They're saying you were
8 at a 16 -- Sweet 16 party and you made mention that
9 "the girls will be so fuckable when they turn 18."

10 MR. FABOZZI: That is not true because I
11 wasn't at that party at the Captain's Inn because I
12 don't like spending money.

13 MR. CAMPBELL: Okay. Well, (inaudible). So
14 that's it, that's all I have for you.

15 MR. FABOZZI: So all them made them (sic)
16 statements, I have the right to -- to sign a complaint
17 against her (inaudible).

18 MR. CAMPBELL: I mean, you -- you can go
19 ahead. That's not -- that's -- I have nothing to do
20 with what you do legally against Ms. Olland. That's
21 your -- that's your prerogative.

22 MR. FABOZZI: Okay. Goodbye and thank you.

23 MR. CAMPBELL: I'm sorry, what was your name,
24 sir?

25 OFFICER BLEICHNER: Officer Bleichner. B-L-

1 E-I-C-H-N-E-R.

2 MR. CAMPBELL: C-H-E?

3 OFFICER BLEICHNER: N-E-R -- C-H-N-E-R. 327.

4 MR. CAMPBELL: Is that sergeant?

5 OFFICER BLEICHNER: I'm not a sergeant, no,
6 patrolman.

7 MR. CAMPBELL: Patrolman, okay. (Inaudible).

8 OFFICER BLEICHNER: All right, you're all
9 set, man?

10 MR. CAMPBELL: Yup, (inaudible).

11 OFFICER BLEICHNER: All right.

12 MR. CAMPBELL: All right, Mr. Fabozzi, what
13 is your date of birth?

14 MR. FABOZZI: [DATE OF BIRTH REDACTED]

15 MR. CAMPBELL: Thank you.

16 MR. FABOZZI: Here while it's recording, I
17 think it's disgusting how you protect the mom.

18 OFFICER BLEICHNER: All right, we all good,
19 sir?

20 MR. CAMPBELL: Yeah.

21 OFFICER BLEICHNER: Okay.
